- A. The proper place where a case may be heard
- B. When a matter that has been determined or decided in a court is permitted to a higher court for review
- C. A proceeding that is similar to, but less formal than, a trial in both procedure and scope
- D. The relief that is sought by the Plaintiff in a lawsuit, *i.e.*, money for damages and/or performance of duty
- E. A written statement made under oath
- F. Confers certain rights on all persons who are under the jurisdiction of a tribal government and authorizes federal courts to enforce those rights known as the Indian Civil Rights Act
- G. Direction or command of a Court or Judge made or entered in writing
- H. A command by the Court to appear and give testimony upon a certain matter
- I. Declaration by the parties of their claims and defenses that also serves notice of what is to be expected at trial
- J. A temporary guardian appointed by the court to protect the interest of minors and incapacitated persons who are party to a suit
- K. A public officer appointed by the government who exercises judicial powers
- L. Procedure where an accused is brought into Court to plead guilty or not guilty to a criminal charge
- M. The document that declares a civil action has begun
- N. The act of notifying a defendant that a case has been filed so that he/she may have opportunity to respond
- O. The response to pleadings, complaints, or discovery requests
- P. A duty to act for another person's benefit
- Q. A person who does not hire an attorney and appears on his own behalf in court
- R. The initial pleading which commences an action and sets forth a claim
- S. The process through which information for trial is obtained by the parties
- T. A request made to the Court of Judge to obtain a Rule or Order
- U. Exemption from duties which the law generally requires other citizens to perform
- V. Any crime that is punishable by imprisonment of over 1-year
- W. Classification of a type of crime ranked a felony and a misdemeanor in seriousness
- X. A crime punishable by imprisonment of 90-days or less
- Y. A case that has enough evidence for Plaintiff to prevail unless Defendant presents insufficient evidence to the contrary
- Z. Governs adoption and child custody hearings involving Indian children in State Court known as Indian Child Welfare Act
